2. COMPOSITION / INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS

Contains: Ammonium Nitrate and Water

3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

Main hazards: No significant hazard.

Other hazards: First aid symptoms and measures described in section 4 apply in the unlikely event that contents of the pack leak. In normal use the product is non-hazardous.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES (SYMPTOMS)

Skin contact: There may be mild irritation at the site of contact.

Eye contact: There may be irritation and redness.

Ingestion: Small quantities are unlikely to have a toxic effect. Large quantities may give rise to gastrointestinal disorders.

Inhalation: May cause irritation of the nose, throat and upper respiratory tract.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES (ACTION)

Skin contact: Wash immediately with plenty of soap and water.

Eye contact: Bathe the eye with running water for 15 minutes. Seek medical help if irritation persists.

Ingestion: Wash out mouth with water. Do not induce vomiting. Obtain medical attention if more than a small quantity has been ingested or if an infant has ingested some of the contents.

Inhalation: Move to fresh air. If irritation persists seek medical advice.

5. FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

Extinguishing media: Suitable extinguishing media for the surrounding fire should be used.

Exposure hazards: In combustion emits toxic fumes.

Protection of fire-fighters: Wear self-contained breathing apparatus. Wear protective clothing to prevent contact with skin and eyes. Use plenty of water. Do not use chemical extinguishers or foams.

Clean-up procedures: Wash the spillage site with large amounts of water.

Storage conditions: Store in cool, well ventilated area. Keep contents away from combustible materials, reducing agents, acids, alkalis, chlorates, chlorides, chromates, nitrites, permanganates and metallic powders.

Suitable packaging: Must only be kept in original packaging.

Respiratory protection: Respiratory protective device with particle filter.

Hand protection: Protective gloves.

Eye protection: Safety glasses. Ensure eye bath is to hand.
